2020-2021 RESTART & RECOVERY PLAN RESOLUTION TO REOPEN SCHOOLS PRESCHOOL THROUGH TWELTH GRADE

RECOMMEND BOARD APPROVE the following Proposal for a Hybrid Half Day Schedule. The framework for this plan was developed after careful consideration of The Road Back, the NJDOE's 104 page guidance document for the reopening of schools. The plan was crafted after the completion of focus groups, community surveys, restart committees and protracted administrative discussion.

WHEREAS, Administration recommends the following Hybrid schedule developed after careful consideration of The Road Back, the NJDOE's 104 page guidance document for the reopening of schools. The plan was crafted after the completion of focus groups, community surveys, restart committees and protracted administrative discussion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Glassboro Board of Education that Students will be split into two cohorts (Letters A-L are Cohort 1 and Letters M-Z are Cohort 2). Students will be kept with siblings.

- Cohort A will attend school physically on Mondays and Tuesdays.
- Cohort B will attend school physically on Thursday and Fridays.
- Cohort C will be all virtual.
- Cohort D will attend school M/T/R/F.
- Wednesday would be virtual instruction for all cohorts.

WHEREAS Half Day in person includes,

Students encouraged to continue reinforcement work at home (given during physical instruction) for the remainder of that day.

Grab and go lunch provided/offered.

Teachers using the remainder of that day to attenuate to their virtual students from the other cohort, introducing new concepts, in a 30 min-1 hr. chunk.

Teachers may also use remaining contractual time for prep or for meeting with common prep partners and co-teachers. Also, periodic professional development that supports virtual learning can be offered (which has not been an option with our current schedule).

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED the requirements outlined in the NJDOE Guidance and incorporated into this Plan are controlled by Executive Order of the Governor of New Jersey and are subject to change. This Plan is pending County Review.
