For our grant request, we have chosen to continue with a project that has already started utilizing district funds. In the start of 2013 the district began installing cameras in our 54 passenger school buses. With this grant we would like to purchase additional cameras.

Glassboro Schools currently operates nineteen 54 passenger school buses. With the heightened level of security needed to keep our students safe, cameras have become a very important tool for the driver not only to maintain the safety of our students but to also maintain the safety of the drivers. Students tend to naturally behave in a different/positive way when they know they are being monitored while riding on the bus. This system that we have currently begun to use allows our transportation director to review actions on a particular bus both by the students and the driver. At this time the district has installed eight cameras on the 54 passenger buses. With the help of this grant we will be able to install up to an additional six to seven cameras. This would be a tremendous asset to our fleets safety and security.
