**Board Action Requested:**

Review of DLM 1% Cap waiver document to be submitted to DOE.

**Details and ramifications:**

Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) is the alternative assessment for the NJSLA intended for our students with significant cognitive delays. Determination to participate in the DLM is based on 5 criteria: significant disability that impacts intellectual function and adaptive behavior, modified curriculum using DLM essential elements, need for extensive, repeated individualized instruction, substantially adapted materials and methods of assessment, and impact on post school outcomes related to significant intellectual disabilities. Every year the IEP meets to determine the qualifications of the student to participate in the DLM instead of the NJSLA. ESSA requires no more than 1% of the total testing student population participate in the DLM. When the district assesses higher than this percentage, a waiver is required. Currently Glassboro assess 3% of the district using the DLM with 29 students fore ELA and 30 students for Math, both in and out of district, participating in the DLM.

Glassboro CST participated in a tier 1 DOE training on use of DLM spring of 2023. During the January 2 hour delay in-service, CST will engage in an internal training on 1% CAP requirements and Who are students with the most significant cognitive disabilities?
