Re: Action Memo April 24, 2024 Board Meeting

Request Board approval for a Summer Enrichment Program serving students in grades K-8 that will take place from July 8, 2024, to August 1, 2024, Monday through Thursday from 8:30-11:30am. The program will be held at DLB Elementary School for students in grades K-5 and at TEB Middle School for students in grades 6-8. Teachers will receive 3 hours of prep time at the beginning of the program for planning and family outreach. Teachers will be paid up to 3.5 hours each day to allow for time to implement arrival and dismissal procedures. The program will take place through in-person instruction and will utilize both district transportation and parent drop-off/pick-up. The program will address academic needs and learning loss in both ELA and math for all students who register. Students will receive targeted instruction based on their individual needs according to MAP end of the year assessment data. Program will be funded through the remaining funds from the High Impact Tutoring Grant and Title I for grades K-5 and Title I SIA funds for grades 6-8.
