WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 9, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the South Jersey Times on April 16, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the final budget was presented to the public during a hearing held in the Glassboro High School Media Center, on April 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has now determined to make modifications to the tentative budget as follows:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in consideration of the above the Glassboro Board of Education does hereby adopt the final budget for the 2025-2026 school year:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that included in the general fund appropriations is \$1,450,966 of budgeted fund balance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Glassboro Board of Education includes in the final budget the adjustment for enrollment in the amount of \$400,962. The district intends to utilize this adjustment for supplies and materials necessary for the additional students; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that included in the general fund appropriations, budget line 620 is a withdrawal from Capital Reserve – Other Capital Projects in the amount of \$325,000 for other capital project costs of the Glassboro High School Culinary Lab. The total cost of this project is \$325,000 which represents expenditures for construction elements or projects that are in addition to the facilities efficiency standards determined by the Commissioner as necessary to achieve the New Jersey Student Learning Standards.
