OPERATIONS

- Safety & Security Drills In November, Bowe School conducted a fire drill and a security drill as per NJ State Law 18A:41-1 (the drilling law). Included this month (11/9) were tests of our panic buttons, related hardware, and communication systems at each school location. For the panic button/system tests, we were assisted by Fire Chief Smith and Lt. Williams of GPD, along with the SROs at each school location.
- Gloucester County Reunification Response Team Meeting Mr. Stephenson attended a meeting of the county reunification response team on 11/16/22. This county-wide team is being trained to respond and assist in the reunification process in the event a county school must relocate off site in response to an emergency on their campus.

FACILITIES

Bowe Construction – Construction of the new science labs and gym locker rooms continues and is coming along well. The cabinetry is being installed in the science labs at this moment. They look great! The classes that will ultimately be housed in the science labs are located elsewhere until they are ready for occupation (we are optimistic that this will happen in Januray). Physical Education & Health classes are held in the gym and/or outside. Students come to school dressed to participate in PE activities Monday through Thursday. Fridays are dedicated the Health instruction.
