SPECIAL EVENTS

- **8th Grade Spirit of Philadelphia Trip (June 2)** – On Friday, June 2, 2023, all eligible (Those in “Good Student Standing”) 8th grade students had the opportunity to participate in a trip to the Spirit of Philadelphia. The trip included a lunch cruise on the Delaware River with music provided by a DJ and views of the Philadelphia skyline. In all, 117 students participated. Ten students were not eligible to

participate due to disciplinary infractions leading to a loss of Good Student Standing status.

- **8th Grade Promotion Ceremony** – On the evening of June 13th, the Thomas E. Bowe Middle School conducted its first 8th grade Promotion Ceremony at GHS. 116 students from the Class of 2027 met the academic requirements to participate and did in fact participate. (13 students did not meet the academic requirements.) The program which featured staff and student speakers, recognition of extra-curricular activity participants, student award winners, presentation of promotion certificates, and a collaborative performance by our music ensembles (choir, band & orchestra) was a big success. - **DARE Celebration for 6th Grade** – On June 2, a DARE picnic celebration was hosted at Bowe by members of the GPD and Bowe staff.
