- Bowe students participated in a Pillow Project sponsored by the Red Cross. The 4th and 5th grade students were taught what to do in the event of a natural disaster. They were also given pillow cases and taught to be prepared.
- Many students are receiving math intervention afterschool. These students are participating in tutoring sessions provided by our own teachers.
- The Positive Behavior Support program continues to be a focus At Bowe School. The students are doing their best to “Bringing their A game”. Students continue to be rewarded for their positive behavior and have had several school-wide rewards.
- The 6th grade students began their D.A.R.E. lessons with “Coach” Corporal Tim Brown.
- Several Classrooms have had Writer’s Celebrations to showcase the students work. Parents have been invited to celebrate in their children’s success with writing.
