INSTRUCTION:

- New teachers received PD in the area of ELA on 9/14. Mrs. Andrea LoCastro reviewed Writers Workshop, Guided Reading, Whole group instruction, and benchmarking with the teachers.
- Teachers are meeting in their grade levels every day after school from 3:00 to 3:30pm. They are discussing new schedules, lesson plans and units of study. They are also analyzing data from the previous year and adjusting their instruction to meet the students' needs.
- Students have taken the STAR assessment the second week in September. This data will be added to their F&P benchmarks to give us a clearer picture of the students' needs in reading.
- Math benchmarks and Fountas and Pinnell benchmarks have been analyzed.

OPERATIONS:

- The first drill was held on 9/15/16. Students were directed in the procedures and staff was given feedback.
- The building was under construction this summer and the contractors continue to work on projects. The bathrooms are being completed and the gym air conditioning system is being worked on.

NURSE:

STUDENT NOTES:

- We are entering the 3rd year of the Positive Behavior Support program. The students are demonstrating a common language and understand the expectations for the program.
