- Bowe New Staff Development Program meeting dates and plan for novice faculty to supplement New Teacher Academy has been established and communicated to staff presenters. There will be 20 after school sessions throughout the year on topics such as classroom management, communicating with parents, meeting the needs of all students, guided reading, integrating technology, etc. Presenters will include the Bowe admin team, Danielle Sochor and the instructional supervisor team, Sue Kornicki, and various Bowe staff presenters. All first and second year teachers will be expected to attend. All non-tenured teachers will be encouraged to attend relevant sessions.

NON-INSTRUCTIONAL:

- July 15th and August 15th Communication to Staff Staff has received via school email two mid-month communications from me updating them with important information to assist with preparations for school opening. It was communicated in June that they would receive these updates.
- **SEL Initiatives** Included in this communication to staff were details about school-wide SEL programs, events, and initiatives. A variety of events are planned from September through June, including a few of assemblies, Week of Respect events, and much more. Also shared were details on morning meetings which all staff will be expected to implement in the classroom.
- Code of Conduct Revisions completed The revised Bowe 2019-20 Code has been submitted for Board approval. The new Code reflects tiered responses to violations of the code. It also organizes codes by levels from less concerning to more concerning/disruptive violations. New categories of infractions that

weren't clearly defined in the old code were added; outdated and/or irrelevant categories were eliminated. Consequences reflect a progressive discipline approach; OSS is reserved for those infractions that truly warrant removal from the learning environment.

- Student Reflection Sheet Students who are disciplined will complete a student reflection sheet as a component of a restorative practice approach.
- Parent Communication A parent welcome back newsletter will be shared via SchoolMessenger and posted the website and PowerSchool Message Board.
