  - The New Bowe Sign is currently under construction. This is a four-week process. I spoke with AstroSigns on 12-9-19 and they indicated that we should expect the old sign to be removed and the new one to be installed the first or second week of January. We have been issued a permit by the Borough for the “construction.”
- **Professional Development**
  - **Bowe New Staff Development Program Meetings** – Instructional Strategies (Special Populations – Part I) presented by Yvette Clark-LDTC on 11-12-19; Instructional Strategies (Special Populations – Part II) presented by Mary Aruffo-G&T Instructor on 11-19-19.
  - **November 18 Faculty Meeting** – We continue to utilize faculty meetings to provide PD support to our staff. Staff notes are provided weekly to cover items for which an email is sufficient. PD topics addressed at this faculty meeting: Preparing for productive parent/teacher conferences (presenter - Stephenson); Using MAP Data to Implement Flexible Grouping (Rittman & Wiggins); Meeting the Needs of Advanced Learners (Aruffo); SOAPStone - A Strategy for Reading & Writing (Stephenson/LoCastro). Our ESL teacher, Ms. Gennaoui also conducted a survey in preparation for a mini-PD session on meeting the needs of ELL students.

**INSTRUCTION/STUDENT NOTES:**

- **Walkthrough observations** – 11 were conducted in November
- **Principal’s List** – A total of 99 students earned Principal’s List Honors for Quarter 1. To achieve principal’s list, a student must earn grades of a 90% or higher in all subject areas.
- **Congratulations to our November 2019 Bulldogs of Character** - The Bulldog of Character Award recognizes one student per grade level each month, as well as one student chosen by our special area teachers (i.e. art, PE, computers, SEL & music), for being outstanding students and citizens and for

demonstrating the six pillars of character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Our November Bulldogs of Character are: Carly Armenia (4), Kaileigh Gruber (5), George Hance (6), and Connor Ritter (6). Congrats to these four outstanding Bulldogs!

- SEL Small Group Supports – In this new cycle of small groups, there are a total of 17 groups meeting with 117 students participating.
- Bowe Schedule Committee – A committee to explore possible changes to our schedule has been created. The first meeting was held in November and the second in December. We have identified desired elements of the ideal schedule and we examined the strengths (pluses) and weaknesses (deltas) of our current schedule. Visitations to potential model schools are being set up for January.
