- Committee Meetings
 - Safety Committee met on December 3rd.

- Professional Development
 - An administrative Learning Walk took place at Bowe Elementary School on December 2nd. The central office administrators and all building principals. The purpose of the walkthrough was to ensure inter rater reliability. We discussed what we observed and normed our scores.
 - On December 2nd and 9th, Mr. Sharkey presented teachers with an overview of the PARCC assessment and its accommodations. He also trained the teachers in the use of the practice tests and some of the nuances of the assessment.

Positive Behavior Support program continues to be a focus At Bowe School. The students are beginning to

suspension rate has decreased by 61.5% thus far this year.
