This is working very well to help us communicate with our staff and to troubleshoot issues with those who are "working on the front lines." I am extremely proud of my staff who have worked hard over the years to develop their tech proficiency. It is paying off now. #### PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

- March 9, 2020 & March 16, 2020 Faculty Meetings Mr. Stephenson conducted a review of safety & security protocol changes with the activation of the panic button; All other PD trainings scheduled for the March faculty meeting (Impero Cloud, Using MAP Data with Student Conferences) were postponed as the impending school closure moved to the forefront. Staff began planning for the imminent closure.
- **April 2, 2020 Faculty Meeting** A full Bowe faculty meeting was conducted via WebEx. This platform proved successful even given the large number of attendees. Topic covered: WebEx Meeting Protocols, Attendance, Grading, district-approved online platforms, FERPA/COPPA concerns, student health and well-being during a period of social distancing, and staff well-being.
- Bowe Staff Notes The entire staff receives email communication from Mr. Stephenson and Mrs. Marchese twice a week, every Monday & Thursday. Staff, under normal circumstances, receives such communication via email once a week in the form of staff notes, but given the constantly emerging nature of the situation, we are sending these twice a week. We do still continue to strive to limit email communications to these two windows to avoid flooding inboxes.
- **Bowe Faculty Classroom (Google Classroom)** We have created and are maintaining a Bowe Faculty Google Classroom which is a one-stop shop for resources to support our staff during the closure. It contains staff notes, faculty meeting agendas, tech resources, general guidelines and expectations for staff during the closure, and more.
- **Bowe New Staff Development Program** Conducted a check in on 4-7-20 with new/novice staff via WebEx to provide support during the closure.
- Safety & Security Specialist Academy Training, 3-5-20 Mr. Stephenson attended day one of the School Safety Specialist Academy training at the NJ Department of Homeland Security which culminates in the certification for School Safety Specialists. Unfortunately, the program was indefinitely postponed after this session due to the COVID pandemic.

# **INSTRUCTION/STUDENT NOTES:**

- Walkthrough observations 3 were conducted in March. (YTD through March 16 117).
- Congratulations to our March 2020 Bulldogs of Character The Bulldog of Character Award recognizes one student per grade level each month, as well as one student chosen by our special area teachers (i.e. art, PE, computers, SEL & music), for being outstanding students and citizens and for demonstrating the six pillars of character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Our March 2020 Bulldogs of Character are: Chance Perino (4), Alice Dinzeo (5), Sunsarai Moore (6), and Karon Curtis (6). Congrats to these four outstanding Bulldogs!
- Online Instruction As of March 31<sup>st</sup>, instruction at all Bowe grade levels is being conducted through Google Classroom and the use of district-approved platforms/programs (Screencastify, WebEx, MyVRSpot, etc.).
- **Support Services** Guidance, CST and the health office continue to consult with children and families, now using virtual platforms and/or phone conferences.

# **OPERATIONS:**

- Annual Meeting with County Prosecutor, 3-4-20 Dr. Silverstein and Mr. Stephenson attended a county-level meeting hosted by the County Prosecutors office at RCGC. The meeting included information presented on active shooter responses protocols, site-mapping software, and the emerging COVID pandemic.
- Safety & Security Testing on 3-6-20 Craig Stephenson, George Weeks and Craig Rawles completed a successful test of our panic buttons at the following GPSD locations: GIS, GHS, Rodgers, Bullock, Beach, Bowe, Transportation/Operations.

• NJDOE/NJPSA Webinars including an "Update on Covid 19 from the Office of School Preparedness and Emergency Management" on 3-24-20 and 3-31-20 – Mr. Stephenson participated in two webinars hosted by Dave Nash from NJPSA and Jeff Gale from the NJOEM. They provided valuable information that included safety and security considerations during the closure. This info was shared at a subsequent virtual safety and security meeting (4-2-20) and admin council meeting (3-30-20 & 4-6-20).
