### **INSTRUCTION/STUDENT NOTES:**

- Online Instruction Instruction at all Bowe grade levels continues to be conducted through Google Classroom and the use of district-approved platforms/programs (Screencastify, WebEx, MyVRSpot, etc.). No new assignments will be assigned after 6-4-20. Students have through 6-11-20 to make up missed work.
- Support Services Guidance, CST and the health office continue to consult with children and families, using virtual platforms and/or phone conferences. The work of the Bowe School safety/School Climate team focuses on students & families in need of additional supports. Donna Begolly and Tammy Belcher have collaborated to create a Padlet that contains links to a host of great resources for our families.

- NJIETA (New Jersey Inclusive Education Technical Assistance) Grant The Bowe School has applied for a grant through the New Jersey Inclusive Education Technical Assistance (NJIETA) program. The grant is designed to assist schools in the effort to develop more inclusive practices, which aligns with our professional development school (PDP) and building-level inclusive education goal. There is no cost to the program, and it will provide ongoing training for the administrative team and staff, which will include on-site coaching. From the NJIETA Website: "The NJIETA project is a collaborative effort between the New Jersey Department of Education Office of Special Education (OSE), the Montclair State University Center for Autism and Early Childhood Mental Health (CAECMH), and the New Jersey Coalition for Inclusive Education (NJCIE). NJIETA is designed for the collaborators to partner with public, charter, and vocational schools to provide Technical Assistance and Systemic Change Facilitation to develop more inclusive educational opportunities. NJIETA will also work to develop a statewide vision for more inclusive schools through the Inclusion Leadership Development Group." Mr. Stephenson will update Dr. Silverstein and the Board once I receive word regarding our status.
