PLC MEETINGS (Virtual through Zoom):

• Wednesday schedules in the month of March (as has been the case all year) were used for committee meetings, PLCs, collaboration with colleagues, and faculty meetings (no meeting in March – Wit & Wisdom Training). Grade level and content area PLCs continue to meet frequently to collaboratively plan hybrid instruction and create lesson components. (Additionally, the Wednesday schedule allowed for students to participate in SEL lessons, Special Areas lessons, and small group/individualized support through teacher office hours.)

WEBINARS:

- 3/19/21 NJIETA's (New Jersey Inclusive Education Technical Assistance) Spring Inclusion Leadership Conference Dr. Elder (Bowe's PIR) and Mr. Stephenson participated in the NJIETA's Spring Inclusion Leadership Conference on March 19th. The conference was fully virtual and included a general session as well as a menu of trainings centered around the mission "to support, facilitate, and enhance current NJDOE initiatives of New Jersey Tiered Systems of Supports (NJTSS) and Positive Behavioral Supports in Schools (PBSIS) with the goal of developing, expanding, and improving inclusive education practices within New Jersey public schools."
- 3/31/21 NJOSPEP "Drilling Guidance for Schools" In advance of each month, we are provided guidance from the NJOSPEP via a "Drill of the Month" Webinar on what drills to conduct to ensure that we are maintaining the integrity of our required drills while also adhering to local, state and federal officials' guidelines on how to keep our staff and students healthy & well during the pandemic. After

each monthly webinar, Mr. Stephenson shares drill recommendations and other updates from the NJOSPEP with the other principals. In March, we conducted a fire drill and a specific safety & security drill as per NJOSPEP guidelines. In continuing to follow guidelines from the NJOSPEP, we will be in compliance with the mandated drilling requirements for the 2020-21 school year.

• 3/18/21 Rowan University Special Education Advisory Meeting - Dr. Elder (Bowe's PIR) and Mr. Stephenson participated in this online advisory meeting and led a discussion of supporting students w/ disabilities in an emerging Post-COVID world.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

• Wit & Wisdom Training (3/3/21 & 3/10/21) – On the first two Wednesdays of March, ELA teachers as well as a number of special areas teachers and building/district admin team members engaged in full day trainings in preparation for implementation of the Wit & Wisdom curriculum in grades 4 through 6 in 2021-22.

INSTRUCTION/STUDENT NOTES:

- **SEL/Morning Meetings & SEL Wednesday** In March, students continued to participate in daily morning meetings (M/T & Th/F) and Wednesday SEL activities that reinforce the SEL theme for the week. The focus for March's meetings was "Expressing Ourselves & Speaking Up."
- Congratulations to our March 2021 Bulldogs of Character The Bulldog of Character Award recognizes one student per grade level each month, as well as one student chosen by our special area teachers (i.e. art, PE, computers, SEL & music), for being outstanding students and citizens and for demonstrating the six pillars of character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Our March 2021 Bulldogs of Character are: Ivoryanna Littles (4), Miranda Dillard (5), Taylor Spera (6) and Jazmyn Lasalle (6). Congratulations to these outstanding Bulldogs!
- **Principal's List Recognition** Mr. Stephenson and Mrs. Marchese hosted Zoom sessions for each grade level "Hot Chocolate w/ the Principal" to celebrate those students who earned Principal's List either the 1st, 2nd or both marking periods. Dr. Silverstein also joined us for these celebrations. The celebrations included a presentation of the names of recipients, as well as an opportunity for recipients to share the keys to their success and a thank you to those important people who helped them achieve this honor.
- **Bowe Schedule 2021-22 Meeting** A second meeting was held to discuss the Bowe Schedule for the 2021-22 school year on 3-31-21.
- Bowe Schedule Change Beginning Week of 4/19/21 Beginning the week of April 19, 2021, the Wednesday fully virtual day will be eliminated. In-person cohort students will participate in in-person instruction Monday through Friday. Teachers will continue to simulcast instruction so that our virtual cohort students will participate in synchronous instruction along with their in-person peers. The in-person/synchronous instructional window will remain a half day. The afternoons on M/T & Th/F will continue to be devoted to ELA and Math office hour support for all students. There will also be opportunities for students to access their Duolingo or PE instructor. Students can contact their teachers for specific times and access information. On Wednesday afternoon, there will be no office hours. Teachers will be participating in committee meetings, PLCs, faculty meetings, common planning and professional development. Students can use this time to work independently on assignments if need be.
