- Professional Development –
  - Mr. Mike Sharkey and Ms. Tammy Belcher led a training session on PARCC several teachers from both Bullock and Bowe attended on February 10<sup>th</sup>. The training gave teachers an overview of the administration and regulations of the PARCC assessment as well as the schedule.
