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Some Specific Examples of actions taken to support monthly report data

10-10-25- District Nurse Meeting on Inservice Day. Discussed PLC, PDP, ways to support Character Education Initiatives, other concerns as documented on minutes
10-27-25- Collaboration with MeganVarrell- Glassboro Economic Forum and Cathy Torbik to provide ideas to Megan for her upcoming health fair in 4/26. Provided her with written list of community concerns that are seen in school and knowledge of other community needs. Collaborated with district nurses and Bullock counselors for any concerns they may see that might be addressed in a health care setting. Provided Megan with a written list of resources for identified needs and contact information when available.
10-25- Collaboration with School Physician and GCHD to review current protocols for Hand, Foot, Mouth and return to school guidance. Communicated to parents who may have had classroom exposure and ensured enhanced cleaning in affected classrooms.
10-25- Communication with APN from Rowan Cares and DCP and P to help facilitate medical exams and vaccine administration for two students. Communicated with DCP and P caseworker to inform of vaccines still required.
10-25- Collaborated with GCHD related to vaccine titers in place of vaccine administration to ensure compliance with mandates.
10-28-25 provided assistance to student with acute new onset medical concern that required accommodations throughout school day.
10-25- Obtained assistance from ELL staff to communicate information re: vision referrals and glasses needed and also about injuries that occurred during school day.
10-25- Collaborated with Nutri-serve director related to snack offered in cafeteria and communicated with specific group of parents to ensure their child could have this holiday snack.
