  - Monthly Emergency Drills – This can include lockdown drills, central location drills, evacuation drills and/or administrative planning sessions with the *Crisis Response Team*.
- All “medical updates” will be sent home to parents throughout the month of September. This includes information regarding shots, lice and when to keep your child home. Ongoing conversations regarding health practices will continue throughout the school year.
- As part of our Schoolwide PBS initiative (*Bulldog Buddies*) our students are participating in a series of role-plays. Each class visited a specific part of the building (i.e. hallway, cafeteria, etc.) to review the rules and role-play what each expectation looks like. The event will culminate at a schoolwide assembly with Mr. Taibi! This year the event will include “bus roleplays” as well!
