12/3/18 Attended after hours District Crisis meeting at off site location
12/4/18 Continued communication with School Health Supply re: new equipment that was not operational upon receipt and able to secure credit for equipment after multiple communications
12/11/18 Participant in disaster planning table top meeting at GIS
12/18/18 review of and communication re: health issues for students attending Santa Shop at GIS
12/18- Continue to explore issue with new student physical exams not being turned in. Reached out to Dr. Palmer to see if students could be directed to her office. Developed a pre-exclusion letter in consultation with Principal in effort to get maximum compliance possible
12/3/18 collaboration with teachers again, re students who have unaddressed vision concerns. Positive outcomes that some students have started to wear their glasses and some have gone to see eye doctor.
12/15/18- review of data and completion of Annual Tuberculosis Report
