Some Specific Examples of actions taken to support above

1/3/19- initial communication with Nutri-serve director about how to handle potential allergies/ concerns re: gluten
1/4/19- review recall of Phillips AED child pads and checked pads for Bullock AED related to labeling and completed form and sent back to Phillips
1/4/19- preparation of records for immunization audit
1/9/19- outreach to parent of child with medical issue that does impact school in effort to come up with a plan to accommodate child while in school.
1/10/19- Arranged for and participated in Stop the Bleed Training, which was set up for District Nurses and offered to some sub nurse as well. One sub nurse participated
1/9/18- Collaboration and documentation re: chronic lice problems and how to handle
