Dorothy L. Bullock School COVID-19 & Remote Learning Updates, May 2020


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New information is highlighted below.

Remote Learning Updates

- 3/17-3/15: A 20-day learning packet (Phonics, Reading Response & Math) was sent home with students on 3/13 & 3/16. Packets were also made available for download via the <u>Bullock site</u>.
- As of 3/16 Bullock is fully online. To accommodate all devices (laptops, smart phones, tablets)
 we are focusing on web-based programming. This will ensure ease of access and allows
 teachers to monitor student engagement & progress.

 - Read Works (Gr3)
- Teachers are also delivering instruction via pre-recorded video (FUNdations, Eureka Math & weekly read alouds) and during daily classroom "chat" sessions via WebEx. The recommended daily schedule (with essential hyperlinks) can be viewed by clicking here.
- Daily Read Aloud/Reading Response with the Principal via Facebook Live & Google Forms.
- Parent updates are sent out daily via the district page, email, Facebook and <u>Smore</u>.
- Summer learning packets will be available for parents to download. Zearn & RAZ-Kids will also be available to students throughout the summer.
- Student engagement via Zearn Math & RAZ-Kids Reading is being monitored closely. Students are expected to read one text/answer comprehension questions and complete one math lesson daily. This additional data point will be utilized to assist with developing class lists and BSI support for the fall. See below for engagement numbers:




- Food distribution via Bullock from 10-12 (Mon, Wed & Thurs) & via bus delivery (2x/week).
- Birthday Chat w/the Principal via WebEx.
- 135 laptops were distributed to families without access to a device on 4/14 and 4/16.
- Bullock is partnering with the Center for Family Services as a distribution hub for the few families
 that don't have online access. Learning packets will be shared electronically, and the Center will
 be mailing packets home. Families can also access the weekly "make-up" packets via the Bullock
 webpage (click here to view).
- Bullock "Student Watchlist" Taskforce weekly meetings and targeted outreach for families that have "fallen off the radar." This includes students that have not attended class chats and have not logged into zearn/raz kids. If contact is not made, a DCP&P "wellness check" will be initiated.
- We are currently working on some fun "end-of-year" virtual events to provide some closure for the school year.
- GPD has been incredibly supportive in performing some wellness checks on families we have not been able to contact. In both cases, this has resulted in family contact and in students receiving their work items.
