- Field drainage continues to be an issue.

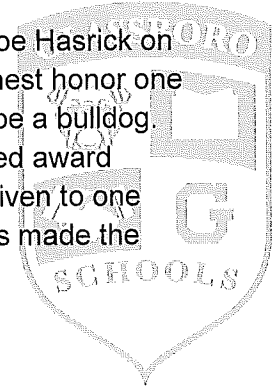
