CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION (C&I)

- English/SS Department - African American history is working on their genealogy projects using ancestry.com, newspapers.com, and fold3.com (all grant-funded). Recently, a student traced his family to 1845 Pre-Civil War South Carolina. The student also learned that his family came to Glassboro during the Great Depression, and his ancestors worked for the Works Progress Administration (WPA). Upcoming lessons will include photos of "The Acres" in Glassboro from 1938 (behind the Boys and Girls Club near Peace Lane). The photos are in the Library of Congress. They are of significance due to their connection to the New Deal program.

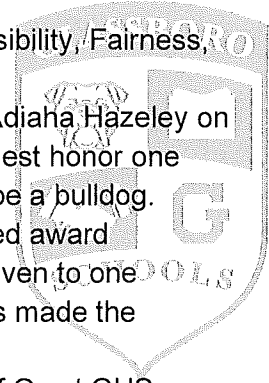
