### FACILITIES

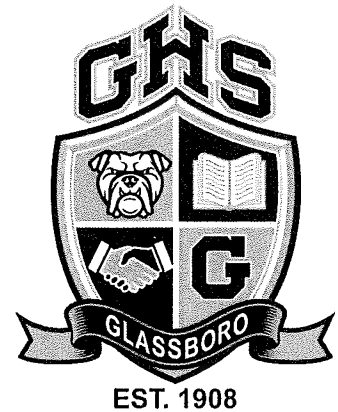
- The Culinary Arts room is awaiting new sinks and counters.
