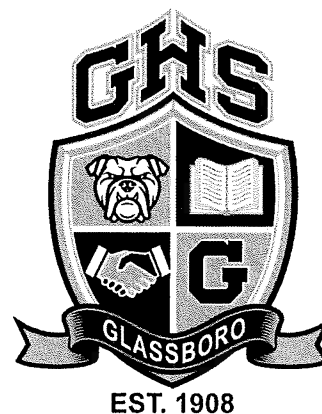

OPERATIONS

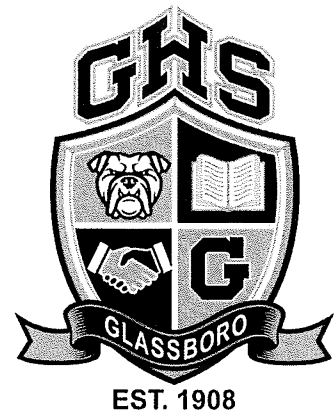
- Drills were carried out in accordance with N.J.S. 18A:41-1 and pursuant to C.App:9-86.

- New bleachers in the stadium should be considered on both the home and visitor sides, as they are currently not ADA-compliant.
