# **CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION (C&I)**

- Virtual Learning Report
  - o Students are adapting to virtual learning although some continue to struggle.
  - Our staff has been doing a tremendous job of reaching out to students who need support and/or those who become "inactive" for days in a row. Our number one priority during this time is the well-being of our students.
  - Our front office staff has been the backbone of this entire operation and continues to support both staff, students, and the community from afar.
  - Paraprofessionals are working with classroom teachers to ensure the needs of all students are met and they continue to support our students academically.
  - o Journalism students met their final deadline; the 2019-20 yearbook will be published and shipped on time.
  - Teachers are using tools such as Screencastify to communicate assignment expectations. This has been particularly helpful in working with those students who receive accommodations.
  - STEM CP Biology students worked on a project choice board to explore how biodiversity affects ecosystems and to celebrate Earth Day. AP Biology students virtually meet weekly to prepare for the online administration of their AP exam. Ms. Memis reviews content and discusses strategies she has learned through her AP Webinars. Students are currently researching various genetic disorders.

#### **FACILITIES**

- Gymnasium Floor, and bleachers should be considered for replacement.
- Health Office New lighting is requested as the room is dim. It is also recommended that the walls be repaired and painted
  due to flaking. Finally, it is imperative that proper storage cabinets be added, as storage is required for medical supplies that
  are currently exposed. The room could be addressed by replacing/adding two sets of cabinets (L Shaped) with new sinks
  (plumbing already exists) to replace the inefficient cabinets.
- Adaptive Gym (Auxiliary Gym) Flooring should be considered for replacement as tiles are missing and/or broken.
   Additionally, the padding on the walls should be considered for replacement due to the condition. It should be noted that this room will be utilized starting in September for an Adaptive PE program. This room also is in need of a fresh coat of paint if possible.
- Media Center Carpet and furniture needs to be replaced. At minimum perhaps new tables and chairs with the possibility of bookshelves. The condition of the rug is poor due to countless stains, tears and chunks missing and/or mismatched carpet patched into areas. The furniture request is due to stability as the chairs and tables are over twenty-five (25) years old and beyond repair due to being fixed numerous times.
- Outdoor restrooms and a new concession stand would eliminate the need for renting portable restrooms and would allow for proper sanitation (toilets, running water, sinks, etc). This would also allow GHS to host larger events in the future and if needed our own graduation.
