Graduation Assessment Requirement (uncleared seniors):

To assist these seniors, the following supports are being offered: Enrollment in Test Prep, assistance with ACT/SAT registration, SAT tutoring, and portfolio assistance. Additionally, GHS hosts the ACT/SAT to allow for ease of access.
