## PUPIL PERSONNEL SERVICES (Guidance/SAC/CST)

 A Bulldog PRIDE Kickoff Celebration was done for all preschool and kindergarten students on September 27th. We reviewed expectations in the classroom, hallway, playground, cafeteria, and the bathrooms.

### **BULLDOG PRIDE**

- We have a partnership with Glassboro High School's Early Childhood Education Class under the direction of Nancy Brown that allows high school students into our Kindergarten classrooms for a practical classroom experience. Each Kindergarten classroom has been assigned a high school student from 12:05 to 1:05 pm each day for the remainder of the school year. The student responsibilities could include working with individuals or small groups, doing bulletin boards, observing classroom instruction, setting up classroom equipment, escorting students to the nurse or office, introducing a segment of a lesson, assisting individual students during "seat work" or reading a story to a group. We have 7 high school students who are divided into our Kindergarten classrooms daily.
- We have continued our partnership with Montclair State & the NJIETA Sustainability Grant. The grant promotes access, participation, and support in early childhood inclusive education. This is a 4-year project to help us "level up", making our preschool classes even stronger. On September 18th, we met to discuss professional development for the 2024-2025 school year, our role as a demonstration school, and protocols for site visits.
- 17 of our Special Education students in Kindergarten and Preschool are working once a week with Rowan University through their Adaptive Physical Education Program for 8 weeks during the fall semester. Each student is assigned to a Rowan University student under the direction of a Rowan Professor who administered a Test of Gross Motor Development and follow up lessons on the fundamental movement skill categories (locomotor, manipulative, stability).
- On September 24th, we held Back to School Night for all of our preschool and kindergarten families. Parents had the option to pick from two sessions to meet with their child's teacher for a 30 minute presentation. Parents were also shown a Back to School video at the start of their session with key personnel and administration from the J. Harvey Rodgers School.
