PUPIL PERSONNEL SERVICES (Guidance/SAC/CST)

BULLDOG PRIDE

- On October 7th, the Glassboro Fire Department helped us celebrate Fire Prevention Week with a grade level assembly to review fire safety. Students even got to see one of the Glassboro Fire Department fire trucks!
- October 7th through October 11th, we celebrated the Week of Respect. This week is an annual celebration in New Jersey to raise awareness of bullying and to promote a positive school climate for students, faculty, and the community. We celebrated with some fun spirit days! They included:
 - October 7th: Blue Up for Bullying Prevention Month Wear blue.
 - October 8th: "You've Got a Friend In Me" Wear a Disney themed shirt, dress, and/or hat.
 - October 9th: Bulldog Buddy PRIDE Wear Maroon and Gold for Bulldog Buddy PRIDE and show off our district Core Values!
 - October 10th: Everyone is included in our "Patch". Wear orange to celebrate inclusion and our kindergarten field trip to the Mood's Farm Pumpkin Patch!
 - October 11th: Participate in a Random Act of Kindness in your home or community.
- On October 10th, kindergarten students visited Mood's Farm. Students were able to enjoy an apple cider donut, apple cider, go on a pumpkin ride, and get a pumpkin to take home.
- On October 25th, our Preschool students had an opportunity to pick a pumpkin from our "Pumpkin Patch" created by our Preschool staff. The students then completed an activity with the pumpkins in their classroom with a family member and could then take them home.



- GLASSBORO
- On October 31st, we held our annual Halloween Parade for all of our preschool and kindergarten classrooms. Students walked in a parade around the perimeter of our playground area for our families to see their child dressed up in their Halooweem party.
- We have a partnership with Glassboro High School's Early Childhood Education Class under the direction of Nancy Brown that allows high school students into our Kindergarten classrooms for a practical classroom experience. Each Kindergarten classroom has been assigned a high school student from 12:05 to 1:05 pm each day for the remainder of the school year. The student responsibilities could include working with individuals or small groups, doing bulletin boards, observing classroom instruction, setting up classroom equipment, escorting students to the nurse or office, introducing a segment of a lesson, assisting individual students during "seat work" or reading a story to a group. We have 7 high school students who are divided into our Kindergarten classrooms daily.
- We have continued our partnership with Montclair State & the NJIETA Sustainability Grant. The grant promotes access, participation, and support in early childhood inclusive education. This is a 4-year project to help us "level up", making our preschool classes even stronger. On October 16th, we met to discuss professional development for the 2024-2025 school year, our role as a demonstration school, and protocols for site visits.
- 17 of our Special Education students in Kindergarten and Preschool are working once a week with Rowan University through their Adaptive Physical Education Program for 8 weeks during the fall semester. Each student is assigned to a Rowan University student under the direction of a Rowan Professor who administered a Test of Gross Motor Development and follow up lessons on the fundamental movement skill categories (locomotor, manipulative, stability).
