V. **Educational Happenings & Community Involvement Activities**

- 11/10/14 & 11/14/14 Traci Dunham the author of "Oyster Secret" read her book to all the classes in kindergarten and preschool. The objective of the read aloud was to promote self-worth. Mrs. Dunham engaged students by describing her role as an author and discussed the illustrator of her book. The students were able to relate points of the lesson to writer's workshop. Also the students asked meaningful questions during the discussion that related to topics that they were learning in school.
- 11/24/14 the kindergarten classes in A wing and B wing performed a round robin. During the round robin the classes rotated to different teachers who performed activities related to the November themes. Activities included fine motor skills, reading comprehension and extension activities associated to the read aloud.
- 11/25/14 the kindergarten teachers had "feast" with the students and a parent/guardian to celebrate the season of giving. Teachers created activities around Thanksgiving and invite parents/guardians in to assist their child in creating projects while sharing a meal with their child.
