Educational Happenings & Community Involvement Activities:

On May 21st, our Kindergarten students did a virtual field trip to the San Diego Zoo. The students had an opportunity to graph animal crackers to great a class graph, created an animal using recycled materials, created zoo animals to place out in the hallway, and participated in a scavenger hunt throughout the building. The J. Harvey Rodgers School was turned into a zoo! The students decorated the hallways to create our own zoo and participated in a scavenger hunt to find all of the animals.

On May 26th, 27th, and 28th, our Kindergarten students visited the Dorothy L. Bullock School for a tour of the building. They had an opportunity to meet Mr. Taibi, Mrs. Brice, special area teachers, and a few of the first-grade teachers. We will be providing a virtual option for our Cohort C students on June 11th.

We have continued to provide synchronous learning for our Cohort C (all remote) students during the school day by Kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Gianna Leto for Foundations and Math on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays and Foundations and Writing on Thursdays and Fridays. This provides an opportunity for our all-remote Kindergarten learners to receive the lessons necessary to stay on pace with the in-person students. Throughout the month of May our Kindergarten teachers also provided synchronous learning times during the school day for our all-remote learners to join in on Read Alouds each day.

Throughout the month of May, we learned about the following topics through Morning Announcements: Teacher Appreciation Week; Star Wars Day; Classroom Plants and Butterfly releases; National Physical Fitness and Sports Month; National School Nurse's Day; Norwegian Constitution Day; The Philadelphia Zoo; Endangered Species; Insects; Being a Good Citizen; Kindness is Contagious; Dinosaur Day.

Throughout the month of May, Mrs. Sweeney has continued to meet with grade level representatives to discuss pacing for Kindergarten Eureka Math, Foundations, Strategies for Writers, and Whole Group Reading. Mrs. Sweeney has also continued to meet with the PreK staff to discuss Creative Curriculum The Cloud and ReadyRosie, our online parent communication tools for the 2020-2021 school year.
