The Gloucester County Youth Service Commission Monitoring Committee completed a review on 4/26/18 and an additional follow up on 6/1/18 of the Glassboro Public Schools S.T.E.A.M program at Dorothy L. Bullock School. During this review we found that most performance standards were met satisfactory with recommendations going forward.

**Recommendations are as followed:**

- Ensure JAMS reporting and program billing are submitted by due date of the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month after each quarter end.
- Continue to ensure JAMS database is maintained specifically Intakes/Completions/Discharges.
- Continue to communicate any program or staff changes with YSC Administrator once they are approved.
