Recommend the Board approve the hire of "Healing Hearts" to provide training to CPR/AED delegates and nursing staff. This training will need to be in place by September 1, 2014

Hiring "Healing Hearts" allows the purchase of an additional AED through saved funds.

All CPR/AED delegates and nursing staff who attend the after school hours training will be given 1 day of comp time to make up for training time. Because this training will most likely not take place until May or June, it is requested that the comp day can either be used at the end of this school year or during the 2014-2015 school year.

## Other considerations

- American Red Cross is a national company with proven accountability history.
- American Red Cross could provide the specific amount of instructors needed to train all staff on one day. We could schedule them as needed for subsequent trainings when certifications expire.
- Inservice day training would require no additional monies to be paid to staff for after-hours training and would ensure staff participation.
- While Healing Hearts is least expensive option, the after-hours classes increase the likelihood
  that some staff members scheduled to attend may not be able to make it due to other last minute
  obligations. We would then need to set up an additional time for these persons to train to be sure
  they are in compliance, and that we are in compliance
- The Healing Hearts option will take place after school hours and may make it necessary to compensate employees monetarily or with comp time at decision of Administration.
- With the Healing Hearts Proposal, we would need to make sure delegates were willing to attend class after hours.

- High School Proposal- Nurse is not currently instructor certified and I am not sure of status of trainer. This proposal puts sole responsibility for all aspects of training program on the district. I would prefer to have an organization come in to do training.
- For Reliance proposal, I would want to make sure they have all manpower and equipment to
  complete training without much assistance from district staff. The very frequent calls and
  inquiries (even after being repeatedly told that we will get back to them) causes me concern. I
  have honestly felt pressured to act before I am ready. I would want to see about training they
  have provided in area schools.
- Dr. Silverstein seems interested in completing this on an inservice day. I think the only entire district inservice day is February 14<sup>th</sup>. We would have to check and see if American Red Cross or Reliance were available on this day and if they would have enough instructors to train 20-25 staff members. Otherwise, we would need to consider another day and have subs in place for the staff to be trained.
