Summer Enrichment Program 2022

The Summer Enrichment Program took place at J Harvey Rodgers and Glassboro High School from July 11 to August 4, Monday through Thursday from 8:15-11:15am. A total of 100 students enrolled from grades K to 8. Students were instructed at their individual levels based on end of the year MAP assessment data in the areas of ELA and Math. Teachers utilized the Eureka Math program, whole group literacy skills-based lessons for each grade level, and the Fundations Ready to Rise curriculum for students in grades K-2. Lessons were delivered utilizing multiple means including SeeSaw and Schoology as well as hands-on tasks. Teachers were able to not only ensure students were maintaining their skill levels, but also provided opportunities for enrichment based on end of the year MAP data. Larger classes at the lower levels were split between two teachers, students in 4th and 5th grade were combined due to a lower number of students enrolled at those levels. Students in grades 6th through 8th were instructed by two teachers with content area specialization – one in math and one in ELA. The program had an average attendance rate of 75-80% for all weeks. Teachers and administration were in contact with the parents of students with attendance concerns after the first week to encourage them to attend. A handful of students missed days due to vacations or health related issues. Majority of the students utilized district transportation with a few opting to drop off and pick up their students each day.
