
Request the following resolution be approved at the May 25, 2022 board meeting:

Project Description:	Installation of storage units in existing classrooms. Scope include removal of existing wall mounted coat hooks and installing (3) ti 72" high storage units in each room. The type of storage unit will be determined during the design stage, however, storage units shall be able to accommodate student bookbags in a locked compartment.
Related Work:	This project includes demolition of existing coat hooks and shelf and necessary relocations of electrical devices, etc. as required.
