Upon consent, children will be picked up from the school by a chaperone and driver than transported to the nearest CompleteCare Health Network health center. Once their care is complete they will be returned to school with a notice of what was completed during their visit.

Services Include:

Dental

Medical

Behavioral Health

Behavioral Health is the newest addition to Health Solutions, offering students the chance to attend group therapy sessions with the guidance of a Licensed Clinical Social Worker. In the group setting students benefit from interacting with their peers to work through issues like anxiety, depression and more. Group therapy has been proven to benefit students as they learn coping skills, increase self-esteem and gain help to overcome feelings of loneliness and isolation.

Eye Care

The ability to see clearly can have a tremendous impact of a child's school performance, that is why CompleteCare has recently added vision services to its Health Solutions Program. CompleteCare staff will transport students to meet with an eye doctor and if needed help children and their families select a suitable pair of glasses at an affordable price.
