Mission Statement

The goal of the Nurses Committee is to collaborate on current and relevant health issues and topics during nurse meetings and district in-service days. In order to accomplish that goal we will utilize the Domains and Components of the Danielson Framework for Certified School Nurses as the guide for administering and evaluating school health services in our schools. We will assist in coordination and planning for compliance and implementation of Janet's Law mandates and complete a Monthly Nursing Activity Report to go along with Danielson Model.

The goal of the World Language Committee is to articulate and improve the world language program between grades 1 and 12. The goal of the Music Committee is to work collaboratively to improve student achievement, increase student participation and promote our school music programs. In order to achieve that we will continue develop practical benchmarks that can be assessed for each grade level which reflect our scope and sequence as well as the NJCCC Standards. This committee will also participate in professional development activities related to our content areas and specialties; both in and out of the district. This would include: Workshops/In-services, we would like to have more content area workshops and in-services, new technology such as Smartmusic, Orff Instruments, assessments in music, and Clinicians/Conductors from Rowan participating in our learning process. We would like to see the NJMEA Conference funded for those members who wish to attend. We will continue to actively recruit students into musical ensembles and provide varied and rewarding musical experiences which are educational, motivational and challenging.

The Science Fair Committee's goal is to foster lifelong scientific inquiry in students. To achieve this goal the Science Fair Committee will embark on projects that will challenge students and spark their curiosity. Students will identify a topic of interest and develop a model explaining this topic/concept. Students will develop an investigation into that topic that will help them to better understand the underlying concept. The committee will develop and maintain a Science Fair webpage to lend assistance to students in the process.

The Glassboro High School STEM Academy's Mission is to provide a rigorous and technologically enhanced curriculum through participation in specialized classes at the high school and at Rowan University that will promote science, technology, engineering, mathematics; and inspire creative, critical and analytical thinking to prepare students for post-secondary study and the 21st century workforce.

The Glassboro High School Fine and Performing Arts Academy's Mission is to provide an elite, individualized, arts-centered educational opportunity through participation in specialized classes at the high school and at Rowan University. Additional individualized instruction offered through Let's Dance Academy, Rowan Prep, and Kaizar Art School helps prepare the students for this University-level experience. Students who participate in the program will be a step ahead in their pursuit of an arts-related career.

The mission of the Technology Committee is to help keep the Technology Department abreast of emerging classroom technologies, review and aide in selection of technologies to be implemented and educate colleagues on the use of these technologies.
