#### **Board Action Requested:**

I am requesting an additional stipend for a teacher to facilitate after-school detention two days per week along with Saturday school twice per month.

#### **After School Detention**

An initiative at Bowe School is focused and relevant professional learning communities (PLC's). Contractually, the only time available for our PLC's is from 3:00 – 3:30. During that time, it is imperative that my assistant principal and I attend these PLC's to contribute to the collegiality, professionalism, and staff accountability.

We are requesting an afterschool detention teacher two hours per week. The only cost associated with an after-school detention program is staffing. Transportation services are set up for current after-school programs Monday through Thursday at 4:15. Therefore, our afterschool detentions will take place Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:10-4:10. Since the building is already open, there are no additional costs to open building.

#### **Saturday School Detention**

Saturday detentions is an effective way to consequence students without removing them from their current learning environment. Many studies show that time and opportunity to learn are one of the most important factors regarding student achievement. When a student is removed from their learning environment, we are effecting the student's access to learn. Saturday school will be an alternative to consequence students without hindering their opportunity to learn.

Currently, our high school and intermediate school already run a Saturday school program for their students in a High School Classroom. In order to mitigate costs, we would run our Saturday school program the same 2 days per month that the High School and Intermediate School runs their program. In addition, it would be incumbent upon the parents to provided transportation. This would result in minimal costs to the district in order to run this program.

#### Cost

Due to the factors above, the only cost associated with the programs is staffing. On average, a staff member would work 12 hours per month, for both the after school and Saturday detention, at a contracted rate of \$37 per hour. This leaves a monthly burden of \$444 and roughly \$4,440 annually.

#### **Committees**

Teacher committee and parent committee was formed and both agreed with the program
