District Wide Projects

• Carbon Monoxide Detector installation will be complete and fully functional prior to the September 5, staff and students first day.

All wiring has been completed and most of the detectors have been installed. The contractor has begun to program the alarm panels with all the new detectors.

Potential Bond Referenda List

- The transition of Facility managers began when Drew Soles replacement, Rich Booth, arrived on-site August 15, 2019. The proposed list for discussion is in process and will include the following:
 - 1. Items reduced from the last bond referendum still needed
 - 2. Facility managers preventative maintenance recommendation district wide and by building.
 - 3. Principal recommendations other than preventative maintenance (i.e. security)
 - 4. Technology infrastructure (i.e. wiring, switches) expiring
 - 5. Technology upgrades to enhance management over instruction
 - 6. Installation and implementation of interactive classroom technology (i.e. touch screen technology, upgrade 1:1 initiative)

Rodgers School

• The new playground is well underway. The equipment has arrived and is being stored at the Operations yard. The installer is scheduled to be out the week of August 26 to begin the installation. Most of this should be completed prior to the start of school. Most likely the playground will be finished the first full week of school.

Glassboro High School

- The Board of Education's partnership with the Borough of Glassboro will result in the resurfacing of the track and new tennis courts. Both projects will be completed and available for the Spring 2020 athletic schedule.
- The Borough is also managing the repairs to the Stadium Press Box. The roof, railing and interior plywood are complete. The roof hatch is open.
