Please see the list attached and the narrative below giving the rationale for the intended purchases with the \$20,000 anonymous donation that was made to GHS this Spring:

Once they were informed of the generous donation, the Glassboro High School teachers were e-mailed and asked what they wished for and/or needed to help drive instruction. As many of the teachers constantly endeavor to enhance their lessons with technology, many of the purchases are centered around that theme.

We hope to purchase (11) sets of computer speakers that can be used to amplify presentations for teachers who do not currently have either a Smart Board or a Panasonic Board. Also, we hope to purchase (10) external hard DVD drives as all of the teacher and student laptops do not have these drives. Each department would receive one/two drives that they can share as needed. We hope to purchase (8) document cameras. These devices are in use by some of the teachers at GHS and the results have been outstanding, especially for our struggling readers. An additional (6) projectors will be purchased in the continuing quest to have a projector in each classroom.

New choir folders are being purchased as the ones currently used are suffering from years of wear and tear. Additionally, a piano dolly is being purchased so the piano can be moved easily for performances in various locations throughout the building, especially from the choir room to the stage. Portable staging is being purchased for the band room in an effort to level the floor which was almost corrected via the recent referendum. Unfortunately, the third question did not pass so this is a partial solution which will add performance space in the room and reduce the congestion created by the large percussion instruments.

Two additional table tennis tables are being purchased for the PE department as this is a very popular game with both the day and night school populations at GHS and some of the tables currently in use are in disrepair.

Our most exciting purchase will be a 3D printer and supplies which will enable our students, especially those in the STEM Academy, to use cutting edge technology in the creation of 3 dimensional projects.
