



Need: Describe the problem or deficiencies that exist which require the improvements described.

There is very little support for our highest achieving students. Block scheduling makes AP scores lower because of time lost between instruction + the exam. Additionally, the SAT/ACT are not parts of the curriculum + students need to be prepared both as a possible graduation requirement + for entrance into Universities. Currently, we only offer an SAT prep Class at night that is not free

Strategy: Briefly describe your plan to alleviate the need/problem.

Albert.io is an online test preparation platform. It offers a huge question bank for students to prepare for all AP Exams, SAT, ACT, + even CCSS ELA + math tasks. Teachers get free access + can assign/track students' progress. Students can use the platform both in class as a regular assignment from the teacher and on their own for additional support.
