Hello Administration

When reviewing the NJ ASK Scores and MAP scores for the students who attended the Extended Day Program, I came up with the following results:

- 19 students attended the program
- 1 student transferred out of the district prior to testing
- Of the remaining 18 students, 14 went up in scores on the NJ ASK in L. Arts and 11 went up in Math (comparing their 2013 to the 2014 scores)
- Of the 12 students still at GIS, 9 went up in L. Arts and 10 went up in Math in the MAP testing ( comparing their Fall to Spring testing scores). The other 6 are at the HS, as MAP scores are in their academic files there.
