Recommend board approve the following change to the Glassboro High School graduation requirement: decrease the required number of credits to graduate, which currently requires students to accrue 140 credits, to 130 credits for students attending GHS day school program OR 120 credits for students who have spent one semester or more in the Alternative Evening High School (AEHS). This will assist those students who have attempted credit recovery to graduate on time and will likewise prevent students from accruing enough credits to graduate after their junior year. The GHS schedule affords students the ability to accrue up to 40 credits per year, 160 credits total over 4 years. The state of New Jersey requires students have 120 credits in order to graduate.
