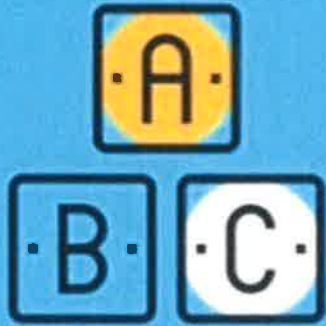
Request to approve the following guest speaker(s):

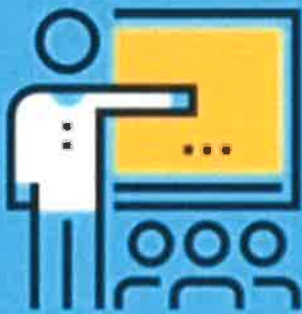
