Work Summary:

1. Testing preparations – Building technicians have scheduled test runs for the NJGPA and NJSLA assessments and will be on hand during testing dates to assist with technology in each building.
2. WIDA testing is in process and is being supported by our technicians as well and have gone very smoothly thus far in Bullock and Bowe schools.
3. Accuplacer testing has begun at GHS and has gone very smoothly.
4. Raptor Implementation – GHS location determined to be outside security counter. Need to add electricity to location and hole in counter for cable management. Bowe Raptor on hold pending upcoming construction.
5. Repairs – Parts shortage continues to be a real issue; despite supply chain problems, technicians continue to triage broken devices. We continue to encourage staff and students to be as careful as possible with devices
6. Data Center Core Switches – 2x redundant Cisco 9500x switches have been mounted, powered on, and configured to take over replacing Nexus 9k model switches. Cutover to be scheduled
7. Wireless Upgrade – Work on configuration of over 300 new access points has begun. All access point switches have been configured and staging has begun. GHS switches have been racked and powered up.
8. Camera Installation – GHS and Bullock strobes have been completed and scheduled to be tied into the network on 3/10. New Bowe school gym door has been installed successfully.

9. Collaboration with Pitt Bull – Team is scheduled to meet with Pitt Bull consulting to create a three-year plan for the district. We continue to work with them on creating SOPs for various systems most importantly the phone system and facilitate inventory distribution for building consolidation.
10. Retired laptops and large screen panel in auction on GovDeals have sold.

11. Several networking items from Intermediate School and the BOE data center will be retired and listed on GovDeals in the near future.

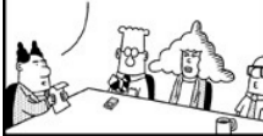
