Technology Department Report June 10th, 2022 – July 11th, 2022 Submitted by Chuck Baur and Susan Kornicki

Work Summary:

- Repairs Parts shortages continues to be a real issue. We've prioritized the triage of student laptops collected so that parts can be ordered as soon as possible. All replacement parts have been ordered; however we are at the mercy of global delays and shortages.
- 2. Dell Model 3390 (Staff & GHS Students Models) batteries continue to be a problem. Batteries are end of life and are failing to hold a charge. Replacement batteries have been purchased in batches but are an expense. We look to utilize spare laptops of different models to get through the last year of the lease expiring summer of 2023.
- 3. Wireless Upgrade BOE building has been upgraded with the new Meraki Wireless AP's. Wireless upgrades for the remaining 4 buildings are scheduled for this month.
- 4. Preparation for "right-sizing" transition Retired switches, laptops, panels, and other hardware has been placed on GovDeals to be sold. Over \$26,000 has been sold thus far.
- 5. GIS ClearTouch panels have been relocated to their final destinations at Bullock & Bowe.
- 6. The dismantling of GIS computer network was completed on June 27th. GIS school technology being kept has been moved by the IT Dept. to its proper locations.
- 7. Remaining GIS technology equipment will be removed beginning July 18th and will be reallocated, sold on GovDeal's, or recycled as needed.
- 8. Magnum recycling is scheduled to visit GIS and Bullock July 26th to pickup any remaining e-waste for the district.
- 9. PC Technician Michael Matisi has resigned. Adam Myers has been hired as of July 11th and will be BOE approved on July 20th. Starting date is yet to be determined.
- 10. Fob reader for GHS trainer door has been approved and being scheduled.
