Work Summary:

- 1. Dell quotes for the computer refresh of summer 2023 (Staff & Student) are finalized and are on the BOE agenda for April.
- 2. ZeroEyes gun detection installation has commenced. Installers have the detection AI installed on the vast majority of district cameras.
- 3. Quote for additional cameras at Bullock, Rodgers, Bowe, and GHS has been approved.
- 4. Phase II of network upgrades will take place this summer as we await key network equipment to complete the project. However, we are meeting with the network engineer assigned to the project to begin laying out the scope after spring break.
- 5. Phone upgrade project continues. Phone gateway hardware at each building is being configured and ready to be deployed replacing older gateway equipment.
- 6. Printer refresh quotes have been received and analyzed. Ricoh is expected to replace our current Canon printer fleet this summer of 23'
- 7. Power specialists have been called in on 4/5 after the network outage on Tuesday 4/4 caused by a battery breaker trip. Waiting for quote to add additional battery/breaker capacity to the Beach Data Center.
