Work Summary:

- 1. Purchase Order for new Dell staff devices is being processed.
- 2. ZeroEyes is up and running. We are awaiting from ZeroEyes dates to do a live test.
- 3. Additional cameras at Bullock, Rodgers, Bowe, and GHS have been hung and integrated into our Genetec camera system.
- 4. Phase II of network upgrades have taken place as we've unbox hardware and begun configuring the new network switches. ETA to begin work is week of June 19th
- 5. Phone upgrade project continues. Phone gateway hardware is racked and mounted at each building. We have begun 911 testing from GHS.
- 6. Ricoh is replacing our current Canon printer fleet this summer of 23'. ETA of implementation and hardware arrival is July 10th
- 7. Classroom management software "Senso" is expected to replace Impero. We are in the process of procuring and scheduling implementation.
- 8. Xmedius e-Faxing has been configured and setup. We are in the process of porting over our current fax lines for each building. The estimated completion time is the end of May.
