Work Summary:

- 1. Student devices have begun being collected at GHS. Collection dates and times at each school building have been shared with staff.
- 2. Dell staff devices have begun to arrive and are being inventoried, asset tagged and stagged to be deployed.
- 3. ZeroEyes live test has completed successfully. However, another test will be conducted this July including more district cameras.
- 4. Phase II of network upgrades have taken place and are scheduled to begin Monday June 19th beginning at Bowe School.
- 5. The phone upgrade project has just about concluded. All buildings have been tested successfully except for Bowe school. Cisco TAC support case has been opened.
