Work Summary:

- 1. Student Chromebook devices have begun being delivered to GHS to be inventoried and configured for the upcoming school year.
- 2. Dell staff devices have been delivered, inventoried, asset tagged and have begun being distributed to staff members. Appointments for new laptop pickup are available all summer.
- 3. Another ZeroEyes live test will be conducted this July including more district cameras at Bowe school with local PD and Gloucester Co OEM.
- 4. Phase II of network upgrades have been completed. We continue to troubleshoot small issues affecting some clocks/speakers, paging, and cameras.
- 5. We will be conducting another test of 911 of each school building to confirm all network voice gateway equipment is functioning as intended.
